Controlled Movement	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Movement within RMCO areas and to RMCO areas and other CMCO areas are <b>allowed</b></li> <li>• Movement to EMCO areas need Royal Malaysian Police (RMO)'s <b>approval</b></li> <li>• Transit movements are not allowed to stop in RMCO areas</li> <li>• <b>Number of passengers in private vehicles as according to vehicle capacity.</b> However, high risk individuals and children are not encourage to exit to public places, opened and crowded</li> <li>• Number of people allowed in goods &amp; services carrying vehicles with economic/activity chains depend on registration license of commercial vehicles</li> <li>• Movement of private vehicles, government departments or private companies <b>for reasons of back and forth from work place</b> or conduct government official business depend on seating capacity of respective vehicles</li> <li>• Activities and services at all airports and ports are <b>ALLOWED</b></li> <li>• Public transportation services such at buses, express buses, LRT/MRT/ERL/Monorail, ferries, planes and taxis/e-hailing are <b>ALLOWED</b> (subject to license rules) based on vehicles' capacity</li> </ul>

Activities Within The RMCO Areas	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Businesses/economic/ industries are <b>ALLOWED</b> to operate as prescribed by the Government</li> <li>• Supermarkets, Shopping Malls and Retail Stores are <b>ALLOWED</b> to operate in compliance with the SOP and accordance to the time of the license/permit approved by the Ministry / Agency / Local Authority</li> <li>• Restaurants, shops / food stalls, food trucks, roadside hawkers, circulating hawkers, food courts/ hawker centres, roadside stalls/kiosks, grocery stores and convenience stores are <b>ALLOWED</b> to operate in accordance to the time of the license/permit approved by the Ministry / Agency / Local Authority in compliance with the SOP of the food sector</li> <li>• Restaurants and eateries are <b>ALLOWED</b> to operate dine-in (<b>WITH 1 METRE SOCIAL DISTANCING BETWEEN CUSTOMERS</b>), take away, delivery or drive through in compliance to the <b>Food Sector SOP (Premiered Businesses, Non-Premise Hawkers, Markets in Buildings and Retail/Various Foods &amp; Beverages.)</b> Operation hours allowed are from 6.00 am to 2.00 am (subject to license terms).</li> <li>• Daily market operations, wholesale markets, farmers markets, night markets and Late Night Bazaars (uptown, downtown and such) are in accordance with normal operating hours (subject to local authorities) with compliance of SOP and the practice of the new norms.</li> <li>• Fuelling operation hours for petrol stations are in accordance with the license/permit approved by Ministry / Agency / Local Authority.</li> <li>• Launderette is <b>ALLOWED</b> to operate and the time of operations are in accordance to the license/permit approved by the Ministry/Agency/Local Authority.</li> <li>• Operations of other businesses for daily needs are <b>ALLOWED</b> to operate and the time of operations in compliance with the license/permit approved by the Ministry/Agency/Local Authority</li> </ul>

Action	Brief Description
Medical/ Healthcare Services	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The operating hours of Government and private clinics and hospitals are <b>ALLOWED</b> to operate 24 hours or according to time set by the Government</li> <li>• Pharmacies and drug stores can operate in accordance to the time of the license terms</li> </ul>
Healthcare Services Protocol	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The owner of the premises ensures control of the entry and exit of customers to the premises with 1 meter physical distancing</li> <li>• The owner of the premises ensures that customers check in to the premises using MySejahtera or writing their names and phone number manually, including scanning their body temperature. For those with body temperature 37.5 degrees Celsius and above is <b>NOT ALLOWED</b> to enter the premises</li> <li>• The owner of the premises limits the number of customers on the premises with 1 meter physical distancing radius at a time and displays the maximum number of customers who are in the premises</li> <li>• Employees, suppliers and customers are required to wear face masks properly according to MOH recommendations while in the premises</li> <li>• Obligatory to wear face mask especially in crowded public areas</li> </ul>
Work Activities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Movement in and out from RMCO areas to CMCO areas is <b>ALLOWED</b></li> <li>• Movement in and out of RMCO areas to EMCO areas is <b>NOT ALLOWED</b> except for Essential Services</li> </ul>

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Action	Brief Description
Sports and Recreational Activities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Sports and recreational activities are <b>ALLOWED</b> with compliance to the SOP of the Sports and Recreational Sector</li> </ul>
Sector Economy and Industry Activities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Economic and Industrial sector activities in the RMCO areas are to be carried out as prescribed by the Government with compliance to the SOP</li> <li>• All vehicles concerning industries, businesses and factories are <b>ALLOWED</b> to operate crossing district and state borders</li> </ul>
Fishing, Farming and Agricultural Sector Activities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Fishing, farming, agricultural, breeding and others concerning food chain are <b>ALLOWED</b> to operate</li> </ul>
Religious Activities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Masjid and surau activities are <b>ALLOWED</b> with compliance to the SOP of the Mosques &amp; Surau activities and resolution by the State Religious Authority</li> <li>• Activities at non-Muslim religious houses are <b>ALLOWED</b> with compliance to the SOP of the Social Sector – Non Muslim Religious Houses</li> </ul>
Education	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Schools, Public &amp; Private Institution of Higher Education, Skills Training Institutes, Tahfiz centres and other educational institutions are opened</li> <li>• Tuition, music, dance, arts, paid study, language paid classes and so on</li> </ul>

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Creative Industries	• Creative sector and industry activities are <b>ALLOWED</b> WITH COMPLIANCE TO THE CREATIVE SECTOR INDUSTRY
Day Cares, Montessorios and Kindergartens	• Day cares, Montessorios and Kindergartens are allowed to operate with compliance to the SOP of Social Care Sector (Kindergarten)
Meetings	• Face to face meetings for official/work at offices, hotels, convention centres and other institutions are <b>ALLOWED</b> by complying with social distancing and wearing of face mask
Mass Ceremony Organisation	• Official and Non-Official Ceremonies of Government and Private, Social Events such as feasts (kenduri), weddings and engagements, receptions, aqiqah ceremony, holy ceremony (doa selamat), tahlil, birthday celebrations, reunions, retreats and other social events are <b>ALLOWED</b> in accordance with the Government Council Implementation of General SOP & Private and General SOP of Social Council Implementation
Other Allowable Activities	• Other activities non-included in the Negative List are <b>ALLOWED</b> based on available SOP

Entertainment Activities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Activities at night clubs or pubs except for restaurants in the pub and night clubs</li> </ul>
Sports and Recreational Activities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Sporting events and tournaments with attendance of spectators and events and tournaments involving participants from overseas</li> </ul>
Tourism Activities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Tourism activities to CMCO areas (Except in green zones within CMCO areas) and EMCO.</li> <li>• Tourism activities to overseas by citizens and local tourism activities involving foreign tourists entering Malaysia (except foreign tourists from countries specified by Ministries)</li> </ul>
Other Non-Allowable Activities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Any activities that can cause mass of people attending at a single location until difficulty in maintaining social distancing and abiding instructions from DG of MOH</li> <li>• Other matters decided by Government from time to time</li> </ul>

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
